Order Abolishing the Office of the Brewster County Surveyor

On this the 2nd day of May, 2018, in a duly noticed regular meeting of Commissioners Court, acting under Article XVI, Section 44(c), Texas Constitution, the Brewster County Commissioners Court calls an election to abolish the office of County Surveyor in the county, the election to be held as a special countywide election on the November 2018 uniform date in conjunction with the general election for state and county officers. The office of County Surveyor in the county is abolished effective upon the election canvass if a majority of the voters of the county voting on the question at that election approve the abolition. The Commissioners Court orders the ballot for the election to be printed to provide for voting for or against the proposition: "Abolishing the office of county surveyor of this county."
